

IMPACT 2017 - QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

What are Schools/Family Groups?

Students who come to IMPACT will be placed in one of four schools, depending on the grade they will be entering in the fall of 2017 or in Black School if their application is accepted. School sessions are designed to provide meaningful training in discipleship and evangelism. Each school will be divided into groups of 6-10 students. These groups are called *families*.

RED SCHOOL - all students entering 7th and 8th grades

BLUE SCHOOL - all students entering 9th-10th grade

ORANGE SCHOOL - all students entering the 11th grade through 2017 grads

BLACK SCHOOL* - Leadership School for a limited number of Seniors and '17 graduates who are up for a week of serving and experiencing God in a fresh, new way!

**Students interested in attending Black School must submit a Black School Application in addition to the Student registration form. A Pastor Recommendation is also required.*

We reserve the right to adjust the age levels for each school in order for us to reach a balance in school enrollment.

What about Free Time?

Free Time of recreational opportunities including indoor swimming, basketball, volleyball, football, soccer, kickball, wiffleball, dodgeball, running or walking, taking a nap, wii, board games, spending time with friends, and much more!

What time do I need to be at Buena Vista University?
