What is a Messenger?

A Messenger is a representative sent by an affiliated BCI church. Each Messenger is tasked with participating in the BCI Annual Meeting by voting on annual items such as our Executive Board and budget.

Messenger or Guest?

There are 2 types of attendees at the BCI Annual Meeting: "Messengers" are approved by their home church to vote in the BCI Business Meeting. "Guests" includes any other attendees and they are not approved to vote during the Business Meeting. Prior to the event, information on how many elected Messengers your church is allowed to bring will be made available to churches.

The number of Messengers allowed for each church is determined by the total Cooperative Program giving for the year.
